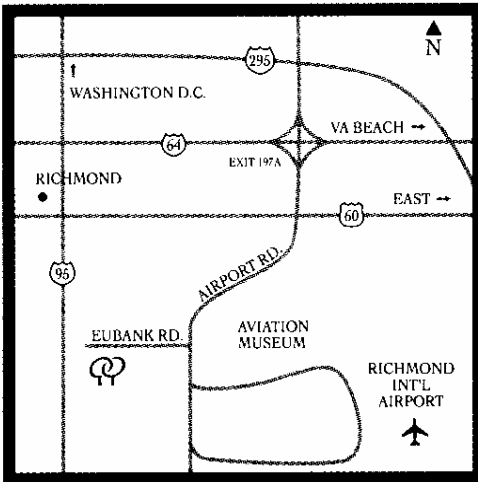


A number of programs and service providers will be exhibiting at the conference and will be able to provide information on their services and products. Exhibits will be set up all day.

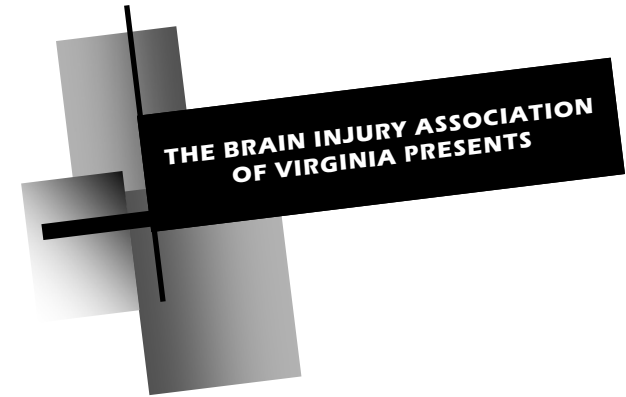

“Creating a better future through brain injury education, awareness, advocacy, and support”

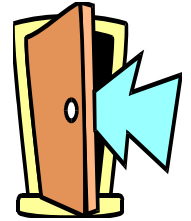
